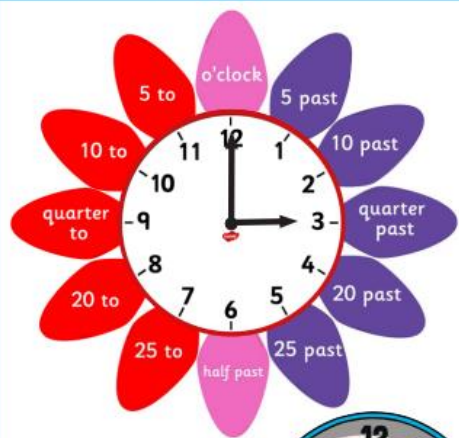

Telling Time to 5 Minutes

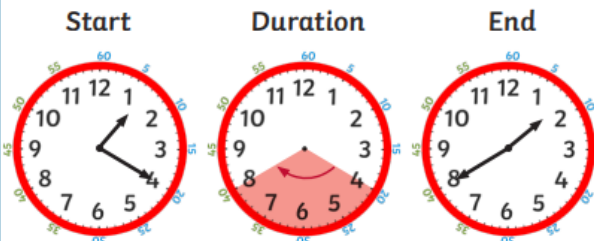


Hour Hand
The short hand points to the hour.
If this hand is pointing between hours, it is either past the earlier hour or to the later hour.



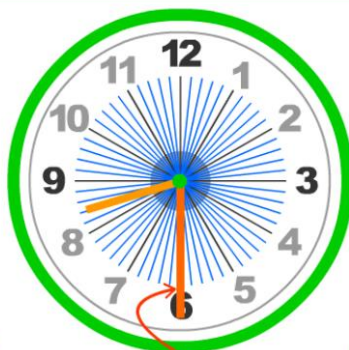
Minute Hand
The long hand points to the minutes past or to the hour.

Find Durations of Time



20 minutes has passed.
60 minutes = 1 hour

There are 5 minutes between each number on a 12-hour clock.
